1. **Head of Officiating (Alberta Bicycle Association position)**
  - a. Must hold an **A** level CCA Commissaire license or higher
2. **Assistant Head of Officiating (Alberta Bicycle Association BMX position)**
  - a. Must hold an **A** level CCA Commissaire license or higher
3. Chief Commissaire
  - a. Must hold an **A** level CCA Commissaire license or higher
  - b. Pays \$60 per Provincial
4. Technical Assistant
  - a. Must hold an **A** level CCA Commissaire license or higher
  - b. Pays \$60 per Provincial
5. Assistant Chief Commissaire
  - a. Must hold an **B** level CCA Commissaire license or higher
  - b. Pays \$60 per Provincial
6. Head Scorer
  - a. Must hold an **B** level CCA Commissaire license or higher
  - b. Pays \$60 per Provincial
7. Head Stager
  - a. Must hold an **B** level CCA Commissaire license or higher
  - b. Pays \$60 per Provincial
8. Race Secretary
  - a. Must hold an **B** level CCA Commissaire license or higher
  - b. Pays \$60 per Provincial
9. Finish Line Personnel
  - a. Must hold an **C** level CCA Commissaire license or higher
  - b. Six required per Provincial
  - c. Pays one registration fee per volunteer per Provincial
10. Staging Personnel
  - a. Must hold an **C** level CCA Commissaire license or higher
  - b. Three required per Provincial
  - c. Pays one registration fee per volunteer per Provincial
11. Track Personnel
  - a. Must hold an **C** level CCA Commissaire license or higher
  - b. Six to eight required per Provincial
  - c. Pays one registration fee per volunteer per Provincial
12. First Aid – pays one registration fee per volunteer per Provincial
13. Announcer – pays one registration fee

To become a “C” level Commissaire you must take and pass the Commissaire course which is offered at least once per year early in the season.

To become a “B” level or “A” level Commissaire you must work your way up through all the positions.
